Most of you know about my challenging 2009, but some may not, so I thought I would update you.

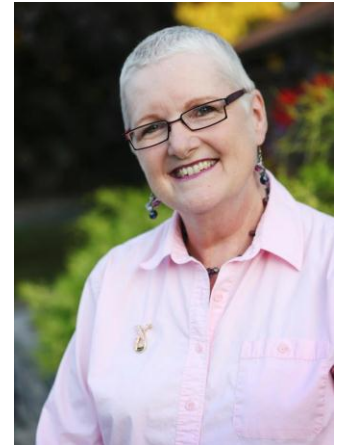
